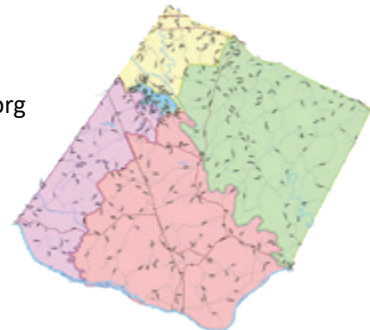

Payment is due one week before program starts. A \$20 charge is added for returned checks.

If supplies were purchased on your behalf, that amount may also be deducted from your refund. Allow up to 30 days for your refund to be returned. MEMBERSHIP: There is no cost to be a Member. You must be at least 55 years old and register at your first meeting, and then attend regularly, (2 out of 3 meetings) in order to be considered a Member.

CENTER DAYS: When not on a trip, we are open; 10AM - 2PM. Visitors and volunteers are welcome. *We socialize, exercise, play games, do crafts, plan trips.* You can visit as your schedule allows. However, if you'd like to get a meal provided by FCPR while you're there, you must sign up with Faith Stuart at FCPR at least a day in advance.

Each facility has a refrigerator, if you'd like to bring your own beverage/snacks/lunch.

SENIOR RESOURCES: Being a Member, means you will be alerted regarding services offered to seniors by any of our community partners: Triad, Virginia Tech Extension Office, JABA, the high school, local church groups, and the Virginia Department of Veterans Services.

TRIPS: Center Trips are planned for, and catered to, the membership of each center. FCPR offsets costs of trips for our Members. What each Member will pay is decided on, at least two weeks in advance of the trip, and can be paid to FCPR, up to the morning of the trip.

LARGER TRIPS: Being a Member, includes you in the larger group of all four centers. This means you will be invited to attend FCPR's larger events and trips.

2025 Fluvanna Master Gardener Training

VCE Master Gardener Training is the first step to sharing many years' enjoyment with volunteers who focus on educating and improving our community through horticulture. VCE Master Gardeners help with school and library programs, information help desks, demonstration gardens, area festivals, and other programs which promote interest and education in horticulture. When you become a Master Gardener, you make new friends, serve the community, and volunteer on behalf of Virginia Cooperative Extension.

The training program is a hybrid of online and in-person instruction. The first class is an in-person orientation Saturday, January 11, 2025, 9AM to noon. Online classes are Thursday evenings from 6 to 9PM, featuring presentations by recognized experts in their fields. Four to six in-person onsite workshops are on Saturday mornings. Instruction will be completed with graduation on May 10, 2025.

Cost of the training program is \$200, which covers all training materials, the *Virginia Cooperative Extension Gardener Handbook* which is the course text, and other related fees. *Need-based financial assistance is available.*

HORSEBACK RIDING CLASSES AT EQUUS SPRINGS FARM

Hunt Seat and Western Lessons Available / Instructor: Heather Antonacci

Ages 6 - 96 / 4 week class / \$140 / Equus Springs Farm

Horseback riding classes are open to all levels of riders, ages 6 to 96. (Weight limit 180lbs.) Beginners learn grooming, tacking up, leading, and riding. More advanced riders may learn to jump courses, do lead changes, ride patterns, ride equitation tests, and so much more.

Each rider learns at their own pace and level within the program. School horses and ponies available in a wide range of sizes and abilities to suit each rider. Each class is 4 weeks long. Group lessons are an hour long, but tend to run over time. Riders should come in long pants, need to wear shoes/boots with a separate heel (no sneakers), and dress for the weather. 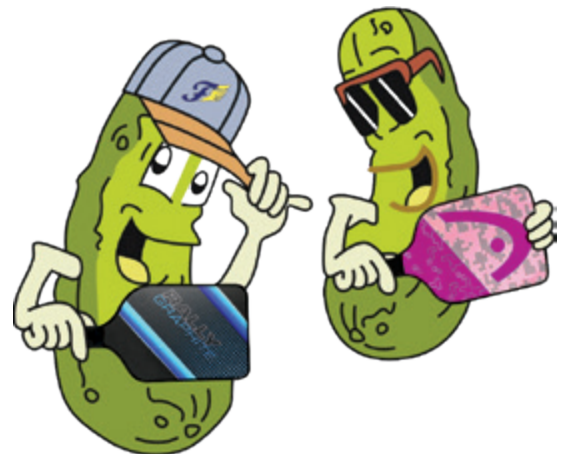


What is Pickleball? Pickleball is a cross between Ping Pong, Tennis, and Badminton and is the fastest growing sport for active adults!

FLUVANNA COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION

The Fluvanna County Planning Commission is preparing to undertake a full update of its Comprehensive Plan. The most recent Plan was adopted in the Fall of 2024 and was a readoption of the 2015 Plan with changes to selected sections. Consequently, a full update of the Plan is needed. The Comprehensive Plan is a guide to the future growth and development in Fluvanna County, and forms the basis on which zoning and subdivision ordinances, transportation plans, and the capital improvement program are based. The Comprehensive Plan lays out a locality’s vision for the future and outlines goals to achieve that vision; outline ways to manage growth and protect what citizens think is special; and assists local officials with decision making.

As part of the process, a series of Community Meetings will be held to inform citizens about the process for updating the Plan and allow citizens the chance to provide input into the County’s vision for the future. Each meeting is expected to last approximately 1.5 to 2 hours and will consist of two parts: A presentation by Fluvanna County staff on the process; and breakout exercises where attendees get to give their input in relation to the County’s future. The Community Meetings are tentatively scheduled for late January/early February. Stay tuned to the Fluvanna County website, Fluvanna FanMail, and the Fluvanna Review for dates, times and locations. Everyone is encouraged to attend and have their voices heard.

After the Community Meetings, Fluvanna County staff will distribute a citizen survey to gather additional input in relation to the County’s future. Surveys will be distributed both in hard copy and electronic version. Stay tuned to the Fluvanna County website, Fluvanna FanMail, and the Fluvanna Review for details.

Pleasant Grove Park: A Natural Experience

Virginia Master Naturalist led monthly hikes at Pleasant Grove Park

Bring the family and enjoy a Virginia Master Naturalist-led Monthly Hike on the first Saturday of the month, meets at 10AM.

- **January, 4th:** Meet at the Rail Trail Trailhead. This trail high above the Rivanna provides us with excellent winter views of the river as it courses through the landscape. We'll consider how the river affects the land and habitat surrounding it. We'll also learn about how the river supports wildlife in the winter season. We will walk about a mile on this gently sloped out and back trail.
- **February 1st:** Meet in the parking lot by the dog park. Enjoy the quiet of the winter season as we walk a portion of the Rockbrook Trail. We will walk on paths of pine needles as we explore this cedar and pine forest. Then we'll cross a bridge over a small stream and enter a hardwood forest to observe the changes in the landscape. This will be an out and back walk of about a mile in length, with gentle inclines.
- **March 1st:** Meet in the parking lot behind the library. As winter comes to an end, we'll take a walk on the meandering Fern Valley Trail. We'll look and listen for early signs of spring in the forest. We'll take about a one mile walk on these trails that loop and curve through the forest.
- **April 5th:** Meet at the equestrian parking area to walk the Birding Trail with us. We will see the meadow plants springing to life to support the emerging insects. The insects in turn provide food for the other creatures that live in the meadow. We will be watching for migrating birds and other wildlife that find food and shelter in this unique and beautiful habitat. This is a .7 mile grassy loop with slight inclines.
- **May 3rd:** Meet at the grassy parking area across from the ball fields to walk a portion of the Brush Arbor Trail. We will walk through 3 different habitats and learn about the plants and wildlife that are adapted to each unique environment. We'll walk about a mile out and back on this trail with gentle inclines.

Please Pre-Register, Children MUST be accompanied by a parent or responsible adult.

Please wear appropriate hiking attire, good walking shoes. Please bring a full water bottle and a snack.

The following nature experience opportunities are available whenever you visit Pleasant Grove Park:

- Visit the Nature Room in the Summer Kitchen with interpretive exhibits and animal artifacts native to the park.
- Visit the native plant Butterfly Garden (brochure available).
- Chestnut Restoration Demonstration Plot; learn about the effort to restore a once dominant tree to our forest (brochure available).
- Self-Guided Nature Hike starting at the Cross Hill Trailhead Kiosk near the Butterfly Garden.
- Hike on one of the 23 trails covering over 20 miles. Trail Maps available at trailhead kiosk and at the Pleasant Grove House Museum.
- Go birding - Walk in the Park, observe wildflowers, native grasses and wildlife. Bird ID field guides and checklist available at the Pleasant Grove House and the Fluvanna County Library.
- Hike the arboretum Tree ID Trail behind the Library to observe 23 native tree species identified by interpretive plaques. Youth scavenger hunt brochures available, with prizes for completion, at the Fluvanna County Library.
- Observe one of the Bluebird, American Kestrel, Bat or Eastern Screech Owl Nesting Boxes located throughout the park.
- Walk the Rail Trail in the Village of Palmyra, using the new interpretative Nature and History Walk Guide.
